- Lessons are delivered in a commercial pool setting and do not include mobile services or private home pools;
- Services do not include recreational swimming, squads and competitive strokes, lifesaving skill courses or aquatic pool entrance fees;
- Comply with Terms and Conditions for HCF Recognised Providers of Extras Services as amended from time to time.
